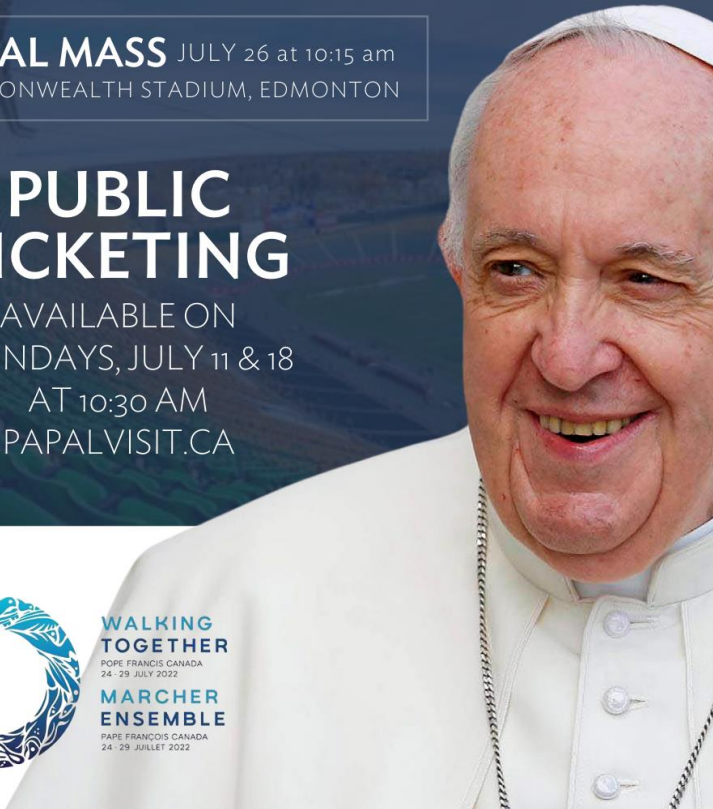

This is the second of our monthly summer bulletins. The next bulletin will be Sunday, August 7.

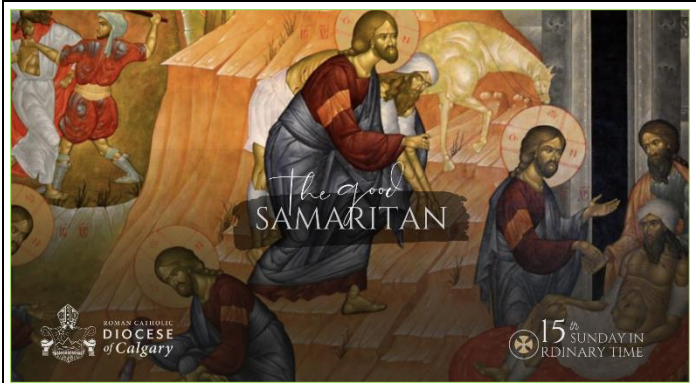

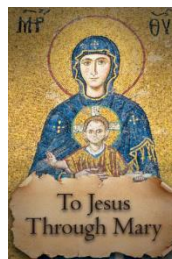

33 Day Consecration to Mary

The devotion, **Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary**, has been practiced for centuries. It involves **33 days of preparatory devotions**, with the Total Consecration made on the 34th day a Marian feast day.



According to **St. Louis de Montfort**, the 33 days of preparation include 12 days of "emptying oneself of the spirit of the world" followed by 21 days of "imbuing oneself with the Spirit of Jesus through the Blessed Virgin." The Total Consecration that follows this preparation is a perfect renewal of one's baptismal vows.

The Total Consecration is divided into themes:

Days 1-12: The Spirit of the World,

Days 13-19: Knowledge of Self,

Days 20-26: Knowledge of Mary,

Days 27-33: Knowledge of Jesus,

Day 34: Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary.
