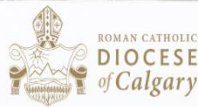

He is married to Chris Brochu, retired Principal of Father Lacombe High School and currently sessional instructor at St. Mary's University here in Calgary.

Struck  
by crises



Worldwide, **one of every four businesses** lost half its volume of sales due to the pandemic.



**Public assistance is weak** in poor countries and for small businesses.

In 2021, global growth reached 5.5%. In 2022 growth will decelerate to 4.1%, and in 2023 growth will fall to 3.2%, as pent-up demand\* wanes and supportive macroeconomic policies are dismantled.

\*Demand from consumers who wanted to acquire a product during the pandemic and could only do so once their finances improved.

Recuperation will be unequal between advanced economies and emerging and developing economies. In the most vulnerable countries, the impact of the pandemic will require several years of increasing income to be reversed.
