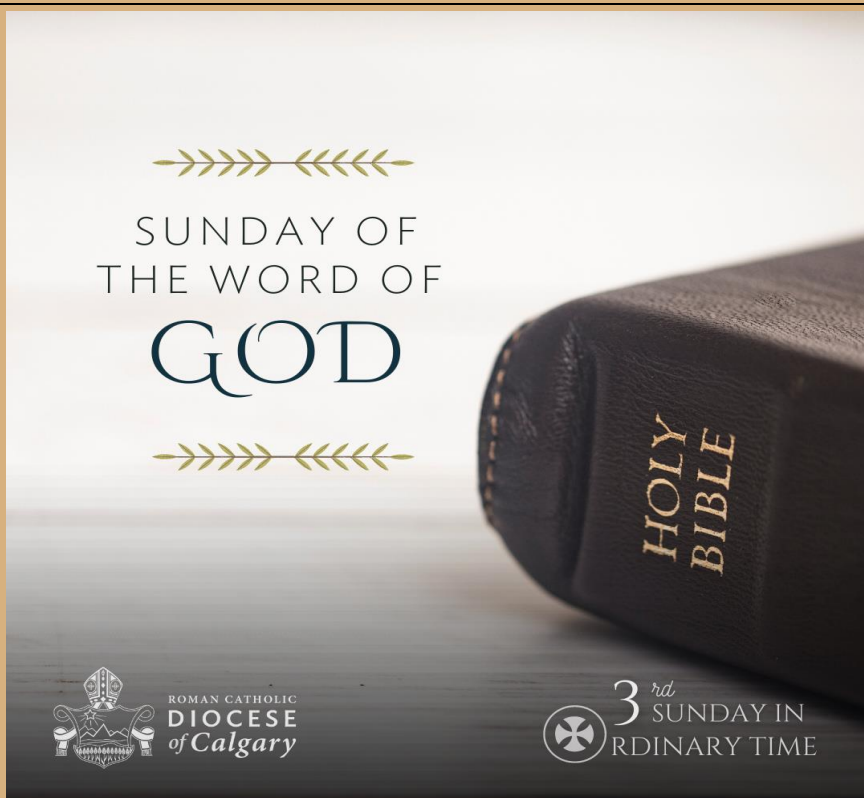

Pastoral Notes

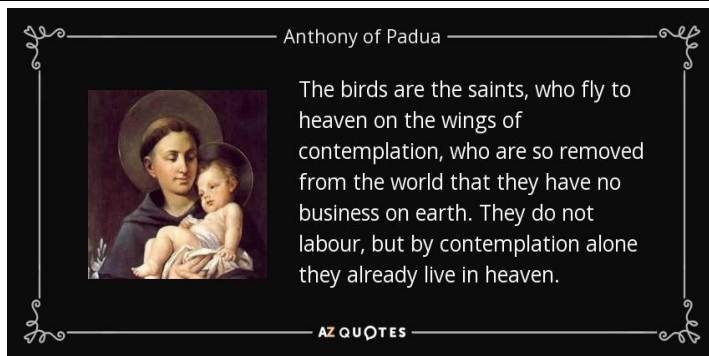
Welcome Bishop McGrattan

We are blessed to have our bishop visit our parish this weekend. A hallmark of Catholic Christians throughout the centuries has been the unity between a parish and its bishop. Consider for example the letters of St. Ignatius of Antioch from the 1st Century AD. As the successor of St. Peter as the bishop of Antioch, St. Ignatius was a saintly shepherd who cared for his flock and was eventually condemned by the Romans to die in the gladiatorial games.

While he was being transported to Rome to undergo his martyrdom, he wrote letters to 7 church communities, including the Church in Rome. In each of the letters, he spoke of the need for the local church to be in union with their bishop as a sure sign of their fidelity to Christ and communion within the universal Catholic Church.

It is in that same spirit of unity and fidelity that we welcome Bishop McGrattan to our parish and ask for the Holy Spirit to be upon him and each of us as we share about our parish, our strengths and struggles and listen to our bishop's advice and counsel as to where we can flourish and undergo change as a community of faith.

May Our Holy Mother and St. Anthony also intercede for us all this weekend and continue to inspire us to serve the Lord and one another.

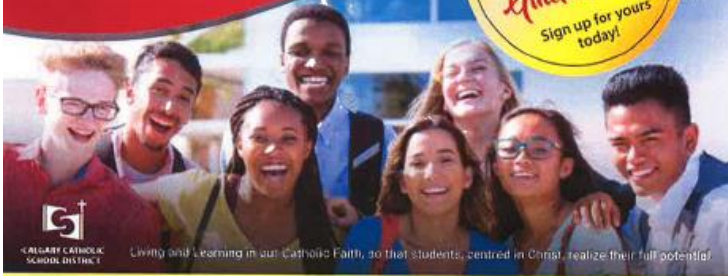
