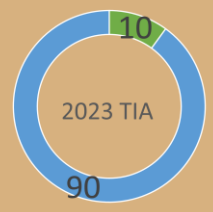

Pastoral Notes

Finding our Spiritual Rock

According to Jewish tradition, the rock of Horeb, which we read in this Sunday's First Reading as the rock from which God gave his people water to quench their thirst in the desert, was taken with the Israelites through the wilderness as a constant source of refreshment during their 40 year sojourn. In the Palestinian Targum, which is an Aramaic rendition of the Old Testament, it states that when Moses struck this rock, not only did water gushed forth, but also blood!


It is not surprising that St Paul interpreted this event in his letter to the Corinthians as a foreshadowing of Christ, who is our true spiritual rock, always accompanying us and from whose Heart gushed forth water and blood when pierced by the soldier's lance, providing the wellspring of the Church's sacraments of Baptism and the Holy Eucharist.

The image of this spiritual rock that accompanied God's people along the journey is a consoling one for us as Christians. We might consider what is our spiritual rock whereby we are nourished at the springs of salvation. It could be those times of daily prayer or our works of charity or those quiet moments we speak to God inside the church or in the beauty of nature.

It can be in those quiet moments before the Eucharist whereby we as nourished by Christ and recall how His Sacred Heart was opened to wash us clean in the water and blood that brought salvation.

If we have not yet found that spiritual rock to accompany us along this journey of life, may we ask the Lord this Lent to help us find it and cling to it in good times and in bad.

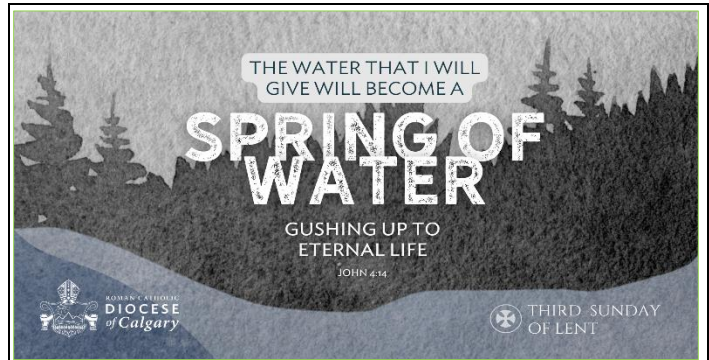

St. Anthony's Updates

Together In Action (TIA) 2023 Campaign

First and foremost, we would like to thank you all for your donations to last year's campaign. As you may recall, the target set by the diocese last year was \$40,949 and our parish raised approximately 70% of that target, thus having a shortfall of approximately \$12,000, which was covered by the parish through its operating funds. This is mandated by the Diocese—that any shortfall is to be covered by the parish.

We move forward with this year, where the target, as set by the Diocese is once again \$40,949. For this year, and especially during this Lenten season, let us ponder the words from 1 John 3:18 "Let us love, not in word or speech, but in truth and action." When we care and serve, with compassion, those in our community during these challenging times, we show, that as Catholics, we put our beliefs into practice.

TIA monies will be directed to various diocesan ministries and initiatives as well as a number of partner organizations and agencies who provide food, shelter and other much needed services to members of our community. Prayers are always needed for these ministries and for those living with hunger, physical and mental illness, and despair, but we, as a faith community as St. Anthony's will show that our faith translates to action and deed. For this year, our parish plans to allocate any surplus funds above target, to our parish's operational needs and any required capital repairs. In other words, these surplus funds will remain right here, with St. Anthony's.

We are also exploring the possibility to have presentations made by a couple of recipient agencies that have benefited over the years from the TIA campaign.

St. Teresa of Avila - Interior Life

St. Teresa of Avila's likens the souls progress in the spiritual life to an interior Castle, God being at the center and the soul's transition from outside to one room to another, getting closer to her Maker. She explains the stages of prayer a soul can go through on its way to perfection. As the soul progresses in the spiritual life questions can arise about its relationship with God and she has answers to many questions, such as aridity in prayer. Through her analogy of going to the center of the Interior Castle, she explains why we can go through consolations and desolations in our prayer life with God and she encourages us and points out how to anticipate future struggles as we progress in our relationship with God. It is a helpful method to see where we are in our spiritual life, where we ought to go and how to get there.
