

A MESSAGE from THE BISHOP OF CALGARY



As the Bishop of Calgary I urge the faithful to continue to oppose the expansion of the legal access to euthanasia/assisted suicide in our country of Canada.

As a society we must be committed to address the social factors which adversely affect those most vulnerable and who will be forced based on their life's circumstance to consider MAiD - mental health, old age and infirmity, loneliness, marginalization, stigmatization, poverty, and abandonment.

As a society we must respond to these individuals and the condition of their lives in ways which demonstrate that they possess inherent value and **that they are loved.**
