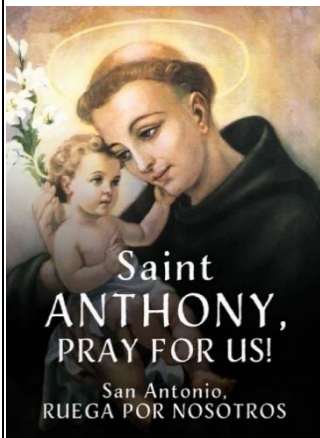

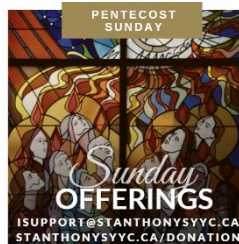

### Pilgrim Virgin Mary Statue Church to Home Visitation

Beginning on June 3 at the Saturday 5pm Mass, the Legion of Mary will sponsor the Pilgrim Virgin Statue Church to Home Visitation program at St. Anthony's. Rotating through our five Sunday Masses, parishioners can sign up to receive the statue and welcome her into their home for one week of prayers and daily rosary.

Over a 5-week cycle, the statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be received from the 5pm Saturday, followed by the 7am Sunday, 9am Sunday, 10:30am Sunday and 12:30pm Sunday Masses.
