

## Pastoral Notes


### Welcome Fr John Kohler!

#### RACE NOTIFICATION

On Sunday May 14, the Sport Chek Mother's Day Run, Walk & Wheel will be running through your neighbourhood. Road closures begin at 7:15 am and will remain in place until 12:00 pm. Residents of Rideau Park, Parkhill, Roxboro, Elbova. Windsor Park may be impacted.

The following roads will be closed to traffic

- Macleod Trail (south bound lanes) Northbound lanes will allow for counterflow traffic
- 4 St SW (between 56 Ave & 42 Ave)
- 42 Ave SW (between Macleod Trail & Elbow Dr)
- Elbow Drive (northbound lanes) Southbound lanes will allow for counterflow traffic
- Mission Rd SW (between Elbow Dr & Macleod Trail)
- 38 Ave SW
- 3 St SW (between 38 Ave & 36 Ave SW)
- 1 St SW (between 37 Ave & 40 Ave SW)
- 38 Ave SW (between 1 St SW & Macleod Trail)


