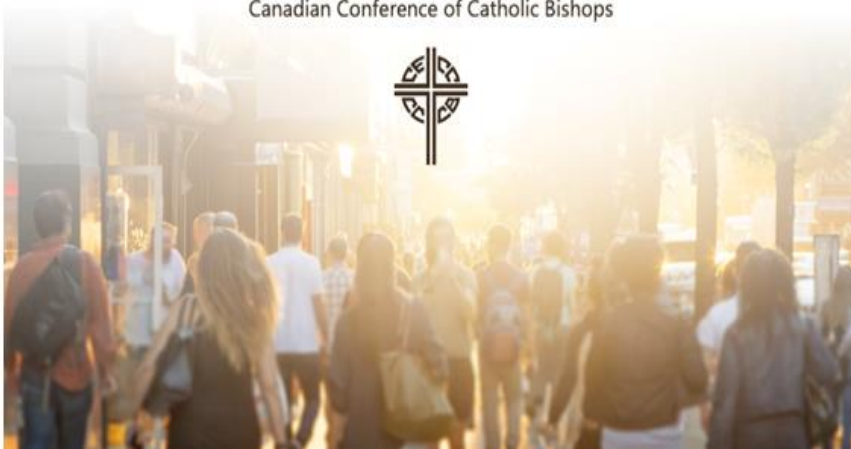

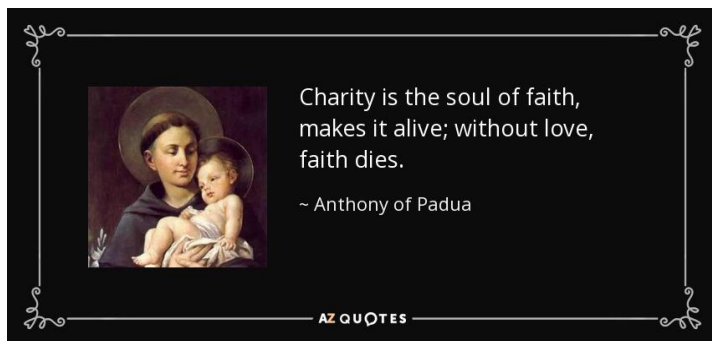
# St. Anthony's Updates

A sincere thank you to St. Anthony's Parish who sponsored Feed the Hungry June 11!

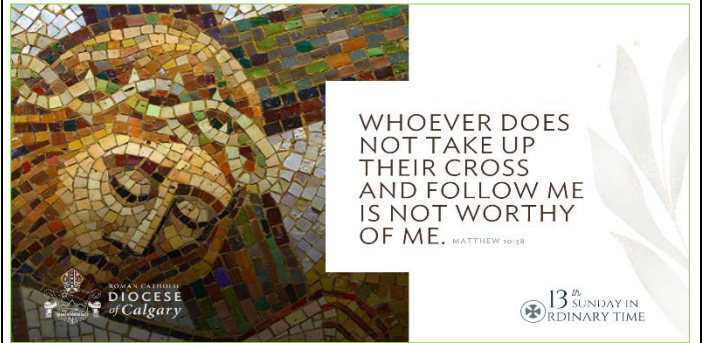

## TUESDAYS FOR ST. ANTHONY

**Beginning, Tuesday August 15, the 9am daily English Mass will be moved to 7pm** giving us two evening Masses and two morning Masses weekly. On August 15 we will celebrate the Feast of the Assumption (also the birthdate of St. Anthony of Padua). **Ongoing we will dedicate the 7pm Tuesday Mass to foster greater devotion to St Anthony.** Confessions will be available at 6:30pm prior to the Mass.

**Why is Tuesday designated as St. Anthony's day?** It was on the Tuesday after his death that his body was transferred from Arcella to Padua and buried there in the chapel of Our Lady, and St. Anthony entered into eternal life. On this Tuesday, innumerable miracles were wrought at his tomb, as though God Almighty wanted to open the floodgates of His graces. As a parish we will pray a novena prayer to St. Anthony on Tuesdays believing that His graces continue to flow through our patron saint today.

Thank you to all our parishioners for their ongoing support - financial, time, talent, food donations and prayers.

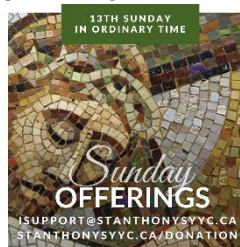
June 24 hamper day we prepared and delivered 55 Food Hampers feeding 127 people include 15 families with 25 children. Our monthly food expense averages \$4142 or \$37 per person. In addition SSVP provided financial support (payment of 1<sup>st</sup> month's rent) totaling \$1329.

Our summer food hamper days are July 22, and August 26. We are anticipating that we will average 55-60 food hampers each month. Your continued donations to our SSVP Poor Box and Food Box at the back of the church will enable us to continue to respond to the dire need for food in our parish community.
