


Pastoral Notes

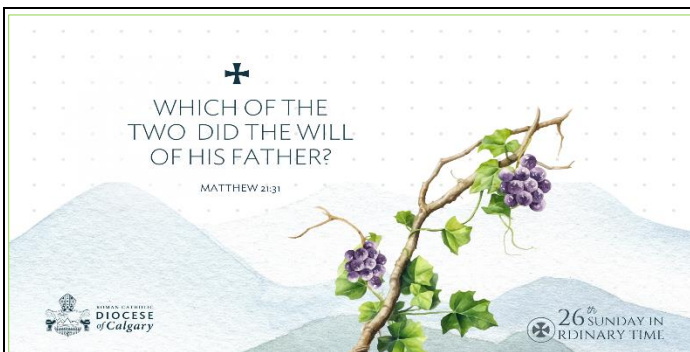

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The **Parish Hall is open temporarily only this weekend** as the replacment of the roof above the breezeway and main hall has been completed. **The Parish Hall will be closed again effective Monday, Oct 2 for approximately 2 weeks** as we undertake the internal repairs and the replacement of the roof above the meeting rooms.

Construction on the Church Columns is underway. The south walkway under the columns is closed. **Access to the parish office will be via the stairs from the south parking lot only.** For those with mobility concerns, please contact the office for access to the church and office through the main doors. **Beginning Oct 2, there will be scaffolding in place in the church at various times** to support the roof structure while the work is done to restore the structural integrity of the external columns. We are working with our contractor to assess the impact on our Mass schedule over the next five weeks.

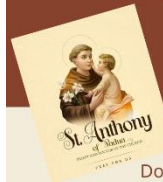

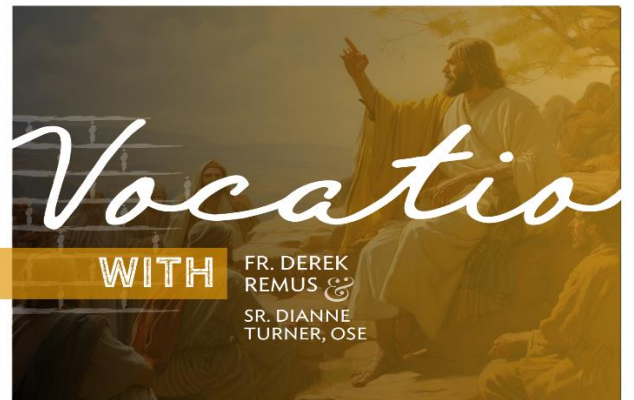
