Pastoral Notes

St. Paul's First Letter


It is believed that the very first letter which St Paul composed, which the Church deems to be inspired by the Holy Spirit and was added into the canon of scripture that would become the authoritative version of the Bible in the 4th century AD, was his first letter to the Thessalonians.

Thessalonica was among the first Greek cities that St Paul visited and preached the Gospel. Soon after his departure, the fledgling church of Thessalonica sought out St. Paul's help to answer questions and address concerns they had about living the Christian life in fidelity to the teachings of Christ. The Holy Spirit inspired St Paul to compose a letter that almost 2000 years later we continue to read as part of the Holy Word of God.

Scripture scholars have noted that St. Paul's first letter is less theologically refined and eloquent than later letters he would compose to the Ephesians, Colossians and Romans. It shows how over the years St. Paul's own theological and mystical understanding of the Faith would grow and his capacity to write on more complex topics about grace, justification, and incorporation into the Mystical Body of Christ, to name but a few, would advance as the Holy Spirit revealed to Him all that he required St Paul to write.

So too must our understanding of the Catholic faith continue to grow and become more refined. We may have been given an excellent Catholic education as children but our knowledge of the faith should not remain with what we only learned in the past. This is why we should seize the opportunities to take part in faith studies within our parish, such as the adult catechism series that Fr Oballo began to lead last week.

May St. Paul inspire each of us to grow in our understanding of the faith!




ADSUMUS SANCTE SPIRITUS
