
Pastoral Notes

#### My soul thirst for you, O Lord

It is hopeful that day after day, a Christian can fall more deeply in love with God. The psalms so often speak of the deepest longings of the human heart to love and be loved. The Responsorial Psalm this Sunday is one of the most intimate reflections of someone very much in love with God, so much so that they cannot keep these affections to themselves but must put them into song.

The psalmist has an unquenchable desire to be with God, be it in the sanctuary of the Temple of old (now we could say within a church building) and also in the guiet of one's home, thinking of the Lord before one goes to sleep and trusting that in the shadow of God's wings (a symbolic way to speak of God's care for us) we know joy and peace that nothing in this way can give in comparison.

In this life, we are so often disappointed in the ways significant others, family and friends fall short of loving us as we should be loved and the ways we fall short in loving them as is their due. This is understandably discouraging and leads us to question where perfect, unconditional love can be found. It is hopeful that the inspiring and confident words of the psalmist about their love for God inspires us to believe that it is in the Lord that this sure love will be found and once found, that it grows in our hearts day by day.



Our thoughts ought by instinct to fly upwards from animals, men and natural objects to their creator. If created things are so utterly lovely, how gloriously beautiful must he be who made them! The wisdom of the worker is revealed in his handiwork.




