
Pastoral Notes

Loving Christ in the Poor

This 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time is also the World Day of the Poor. Towards the end of His Public Ministry, Jesus gave a series of teachings on the End of the World. What is noticeable is how his warnings about the trials of the end of all things were also calls to care for the poor. This was because of the very explicit way Jesus associated himself with the poor, making it clear to the Apostles who were to carry on his teaching that to love the poor was to love Christ who is hidden within the poor and outcast. "When you did it to the least of these, you did it onto me" is a word of Christ that will resonate until His coming again in glory!

The call to serve the poor is one that will remain quintessential to the Catholic Church until the end of time. Everyone of us is called to serve the poor and to ask God to place in our hearts a deeper love and concern for their trials. 


