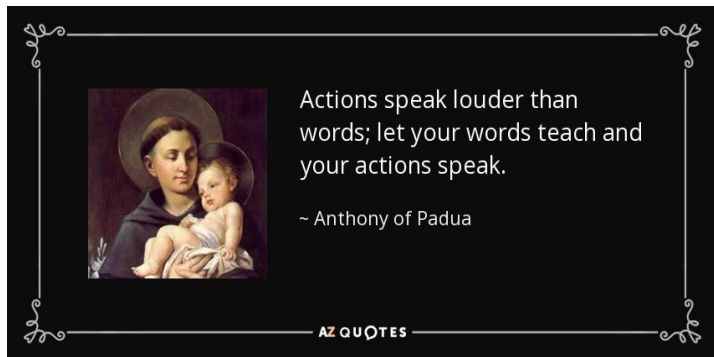
Pastoral Notes

My King

Debate will continue to rage whether or not the Lord of the Rings Trilogy of movies did justice to the hallowed Trilogy of novels that rightly have been declared by the many to be among the finest literary works of all time. Regardless of where one stands in this debate (or admit they are not much of the Tolkien fan, those of us who are will pray for you), one scene from the Fellowship of the King that I found to be quite moving was when Aragorn held in his arms the dying Boromir, and Boromir called him "my king."

His words were those of someone who had not always wanted to follow his king and sought glory by his own standard but with his life coming to an end he was able to declare his loyalty to the one true king of his people who was foretold to return to claim his throne and bring peace.

It is hopeful that every Christian can speak of Jesus with that same affection, simply calling him "my king". Like Boromir, we may have turned away from the reign of Christ at times, perhaps notably in those ways He challenges us in this Sunday's Gospel to discover him in the poor, outcast, naked, and in need and learn that in serving them we participate in the kingship of Jesus Christ. Like Boromir, it is never too late to turn back to the Lord to declare our loyalty to his reign and strive to be faithful to him evermore.

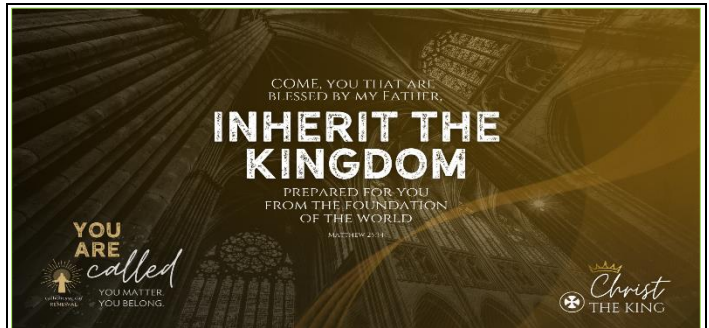

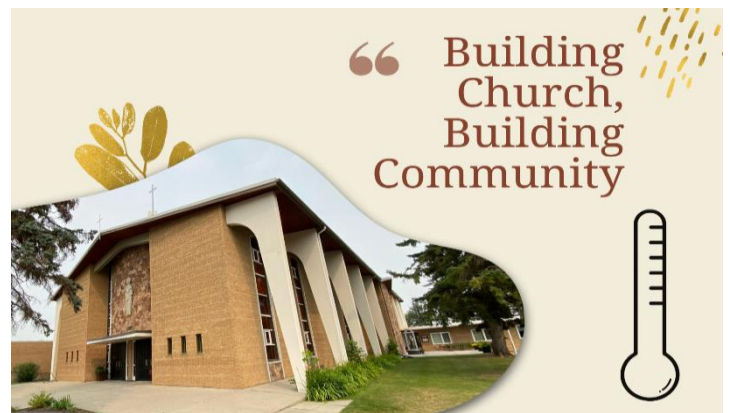

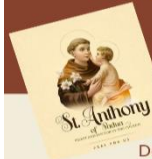
