
Pastoral Notes

Finding Peace

The response for this Sunday's responsorial psalm reads: "In you, Lord, I have found my peace." Peace is an important reality for Christians. Jesus promised the gift of peace at the Last Summer to the Apostles and asked that his peace be shared by them, something we do during the celebration of the Holy Mass when we offer a gesture of peace to those nearby us as both a tangible way to offer peace to another and prepare our hearts to receive the Holy Eucharist.

The peace of Christ is similar yet different from the peace that is sought in the world. It is certainly a peace that longs to see wars end and violence cease, but it is a peace that is also obtained and maintained in the presence of war and violence. It is a peace that endures in the midst of tribulations to allow a Christian to find solace and rest in Christ, even if violence, chaos, disorder and busyness prevail and seek to pull us away from Christ. It is Chirstian peace that allow someone to have a certain serenity even when a lack of peace is all around them and shows that this peace is not a worldly peace, but one that comes from Christ himself.

Dear friends, let us take time this Sunday to ask if this peace is present in our lives. If not, let us ask the Lord to show us where we can find His peace while appreciating it won't mean that all our trials and tribulations will cease, but that in the midst of them we can know peace and find refugee in God.


