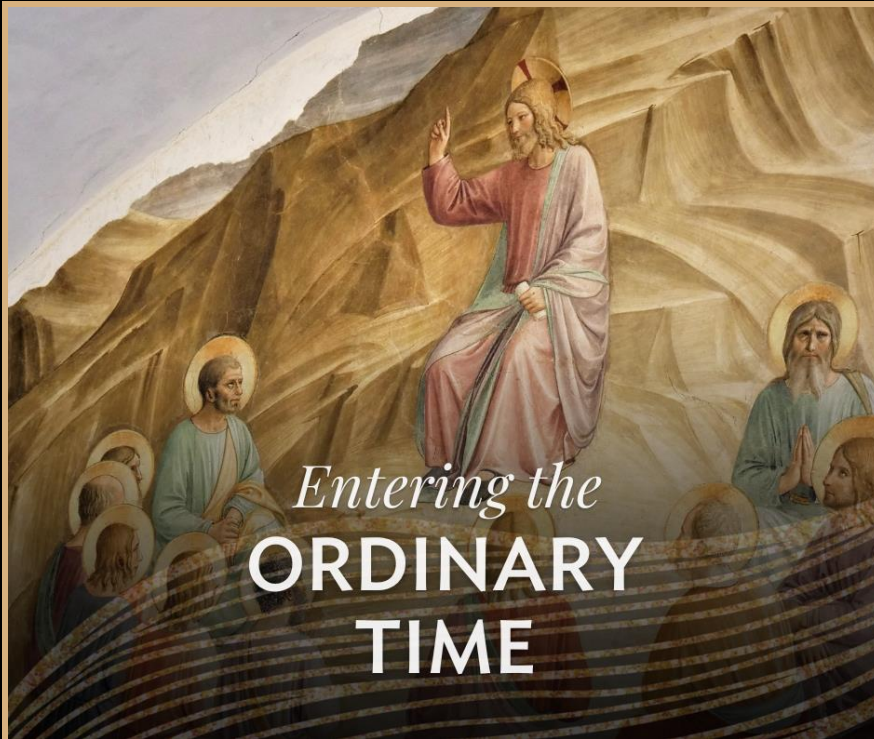

Sunday is the original Christian Feast Day, following the tradition handed down from Apostolic times, for this is the day of the Lord's Resurrection. 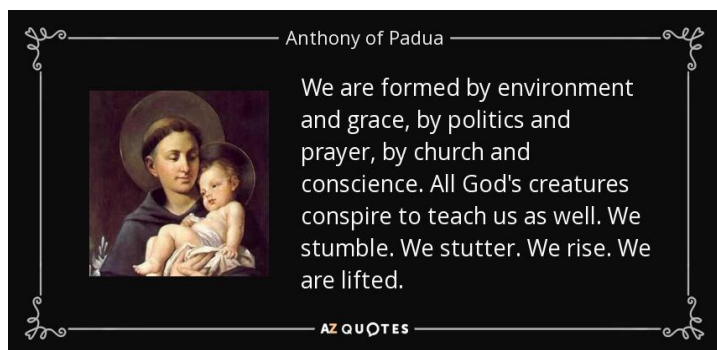
Pastoral Notes

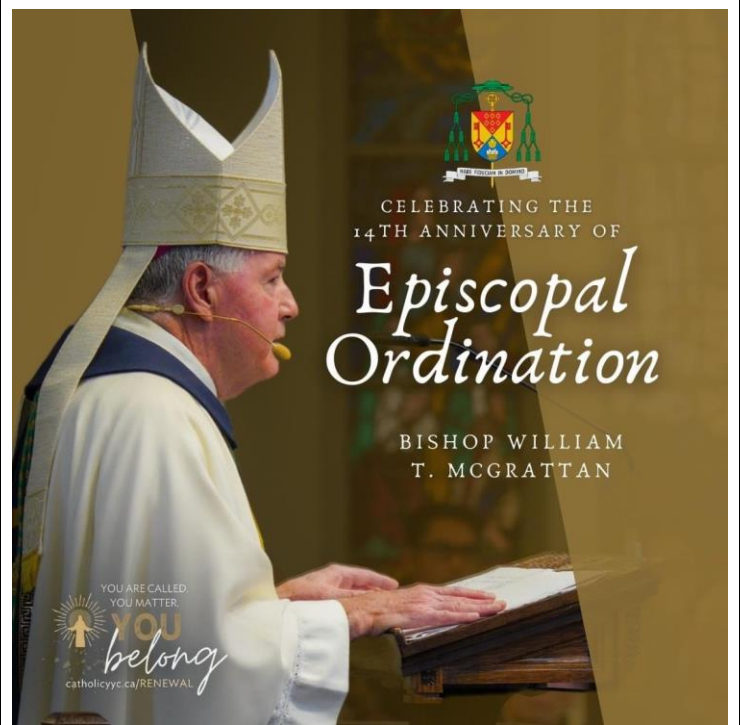
