
Go Stargazing!

I am grateful that the night skies where my parents live in Millarville, AB continue to be mostly free of light pollution that veils the stars in the night sky. Some of my greatest moments in life have been long nights looking up into the heavens and be awe struck by the glory of the cosmos that God brought into being.

For many, stargazing is a search for knowledge about the vastness of the universe and for signs to be provided about the working of God's providence. Such was what compelled the Magi to be attentive to the new star that had arisen as a celestial sign that some significant occurrence had taken place in the Land of Judea, inspiring them to make the journey to Bethlehem to adore the newborn King of the Jews.

But for many, stargazing is undertaken in the spirit of the philosopher Aristotle, who when asked why one should look at the stars, he replied that because it is something wonderful to do. There doesn't have to be a utilitarian purpose for looking up at the stars. That doing so brings wonder, delight and amazement are sufficient reasons in themselves to look up in the night sky and be filled with awe. So too were many filled with awe and wonder at the new star above Bethlehem and the promise of hope that it brought of God sending salvation to a world that was trapped in the darkness of sin.

So whether we go stargazing to grow in our knowledge of the known universe or to look up in the night sky simply because it is a good thing to do or some combination of both, may we always find the Heavenly Father in the stars above and know that He is always with us to guide us to the true star who is Christ.




