
Pastoral Notes

Holy Week with Mary

We can have confidence that before Our Lord's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, Our Holy Mother would have also made her way to Jerusalem. Already her Immaculate Heart had been pierced with the sword that Simeon foretold would mark her life as the Mother of God when she witnessed His circumcision, lost Him in the temple, and had seen Him reviled and threatened by His enemies, and so her heart was aware when danger and suffering were approaching her Son. Perhaps she began to walk along the path her Son would take as He carried His cross in anticipation of when she would meet Him along the way. Perhaps she looked upon the Temple and all the lambs that were being brought there for the Passover sacrifice, seeing in them mere shadows of the True Lamb who was about to be slain for the sins of all.


She had followed Him diligently for 3 years, witnessing miracles like that at Cana and Lazarus being raised from the dead, but now the time had come for her Son to fulfill those prophecies of Isaiah in becoming the Suffering Servant of the Lord and of Psalm 22 that spoke of the crucified saviour. Because she pondered daily the mysteries of God in her heart, she was ready to follow Him to the cross and tomb and she alone would believe on Holy Saturday that He would rise again when all others despaired that the Messiah was thought to be no more.

Let us go to Our Lady of Sorrows during Holy Week to intercede for us to have a similar contemplative spirit to enter into the mysteries of our salvation. May we seek her to comfort us as we mourn our Lord's death and also ask her to help us rejoice when He rises again and we enter those 50 days of Easter Glory.






