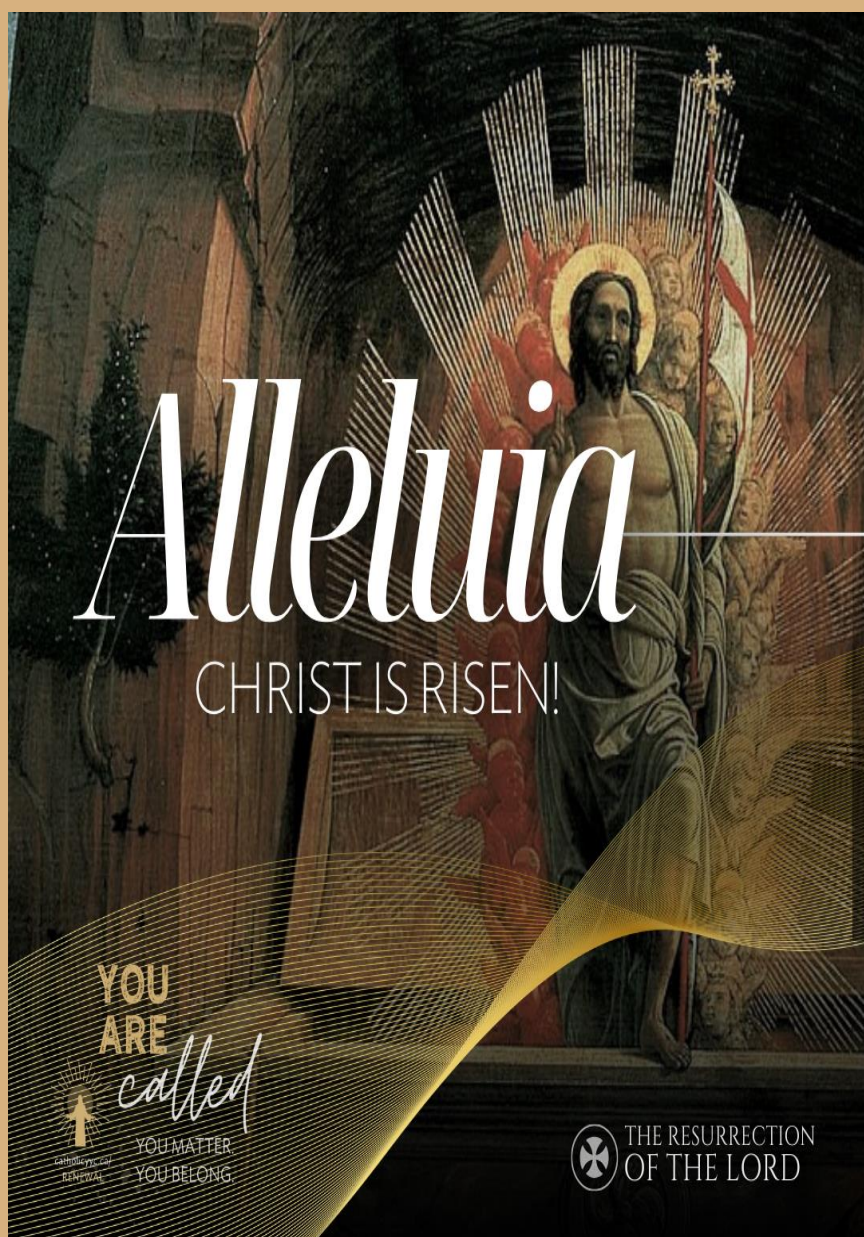

## Pastoral Notes

### The Empty Tomb

Among the most profound blessings of my priesthood was the opportunity to offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass above the empty tomb of Jesus Christ. Within the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, wherein you will find many holy sites like Mt Calvary, the stone slab where the body of Jesus was anointed for burial, the subterranean cave where St Helena found the relics of the True Cross and the instruments of the Passion, and the tombs of crusader kings, to name but a few, the crowning jewel of the most important church building on earth is the empty tomb.

You find it in a small chapel within the Holy Sepulchre, wherein about 20 people can tightly gather in a chamber that is where the two angels appeared to announce that Jesus had risen and an even smaller space where an altar is placed over a smooth marble slab that beneath is found the empty tomb.

The Franciscans who are custodians of the Holy Sepulchre have strict rules about Mass there: You have only thirty minutes and singing is prohibited, to assure that the Masses are offered in a timely manner and that the cue of priests and pilgrims waiting their turn for Mass is fulfilled each day. These limits on how Mass is to be offered did nothing to diminish the joy I experienced as I approached the altar of God and began to offer Mass just a few feet above where the most important moment in history took place: The Resurrection.

The entire experience was marked by beauty and grace, but what was most beautiful and grace-filled about this Mass was when I remembered again and again that the tomb of Jesus is empty, so wondrously empty, because He did not know the decay of death but truly rose and shall never die again.

Easter is our blessed opportunity to marvel again that the tomb of Jesus is empty and will be empty forever since He is risen and we are called to rise with Him on the day of days.

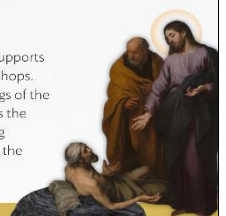

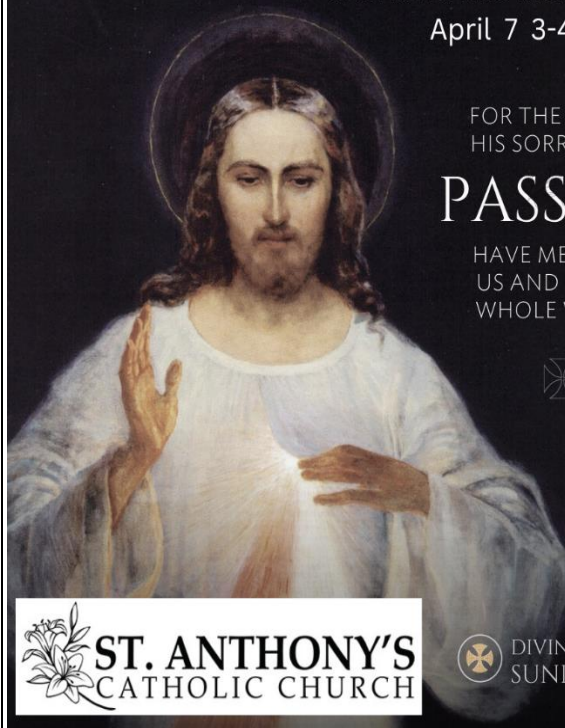

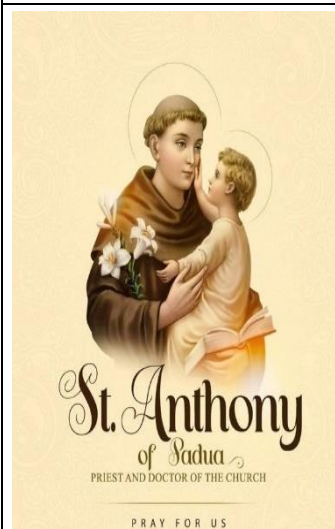
