LITTLE FLOWERS GIRLS CLUB

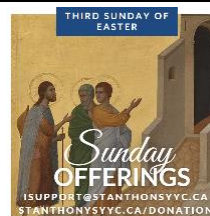

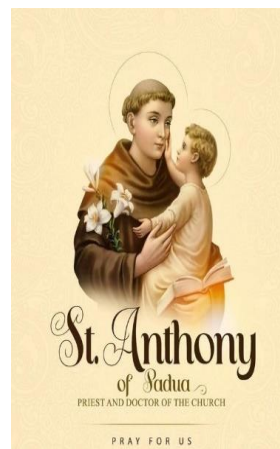
