These simple yet profound words capture the essence of the Pastoral Renewal.

Pastoral Renewal involves the commitment of the clergy, religious, and the faithful in the Diocese of Calgary to authentically grow closer to Jesus who calls us to follow Him and live His mission in this particular moment in time.

### The Centrality OF THE PARISH

The parish is not an outdated institution; precisely because it possesses great flexibility, it can assume quite different contours depending on the openness and missionary creativity of the pastor and the community. While certainly not the only institution which evangelizes, if the parish proves capable of self-renewal and constant adaptivity, it continues to be "the Church living in the midst of the homes of her sons and daughters".

Pope Francis, The Joy of the Gospel #28

In our parishes the Word, the celebration of the Sacraments, the teaching and pastoral Tradition of the Church become our lived experiences, and through this renewal, we seek to invite others to join us in this journey.

The Pastoral Renewal is not a pastoral planning process that comes equipped with GPS technology that is intended to provide turn-by-turn directions or predetermined pastoral programs and/or initiatives. Instead, it serves as a compass to strengthen our synodal experience of communion, mission, and participation.

The three areas of pastoral priority and nine actions presented in the Pastoral Renewal are meant to orient us towards Jesus Christ and His kingdom. They serve as coordinates, indicating the path of discernment and the direction we will embark upon with the Holy Spirit as our guide.



Similar to the early Church, the synodal renewal of our faith communities depend on the primacy of grace, the witness of prayer and worship, communion, faith formation, outreach and leadership. These are the foundations of every parish faith community.

#### WORD

Formation on the living Word of God, Traditions, and teachings of the Church

#### WORSHIP

Formation of liturgical and spiritual life

#### COMMUNITY

Formation of vibrant and supporting community of faith

#### SERVICE

Formation of charity, justice, and compassion

#### LEADERSHIP/ STEWARDSHIP

Formation of financial, human, and temporal stewardship

St. Francis of Assisi, Memorial

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

On the Memorial of St. Francis of Assisi, we begin a pathway of pastoral renewal in the Diocese of Calgary.

What is a pastoral renewal, and why did we decide to launch it on this day?

A pastoral renewal is an invitation to the Church of the Diocese of Calgary to renew and

strengthen our commitment as individuals, parishes, and as a diocese to live the life that Christ calls us to in the midst of our world. We respond to His call through our baptism, our personal witness of the Faith and our desire to participate in the mission that Christ entrusted to the Church.

Our pastoral renewal is being launched on the Memorial of St. Francis of Assisi and it coincides with the opening of the First Session of the Synodal Assembly in Rome where I am currently present with Pope

Francis, my brother bishops, and delegates from around the world. The life of our Diocese is united with the universal Church as witnessed through my participation at the Synod but also in our embarking on this pastoral renewal. It is in learning the synodal way of walking with others on the path of salvation, we encounter one another and experience together the presence of Christ in our midst and those whom He is calling us to serve.

While praying in the little church of St. Damian, St. Francis was drawn to the San Damiano cross and from there heard the voice of the Lord saying to him to repair His house which is falling apart. While mindful of the chapel that was in disrepair, St. Francis was much more aware of the call of Christ to lead the Church on a path of prayer, penance, and renewal. He did this by following Him more intently and in joyful humility living his life and offering his work as a more authentic witness of Christ to all his brothers and sisters.

In a similar way, through this pastoral renewal, Catholics in the Diocese of Calgary are being called to intensify our following of Christ through three areas of pastoral priority that will help us as the Church to become more intentional in walking with the people. They are the fruit of our diocesan phase of the Synod and a year long process of further prayer, dialogue and discernment. In the coming years this pastoral renewal will call us:


- 1 To be intentional in living our baptism and in the orientation of the parishes and the Diocese in being formed as missionary disciples of our Lord.
- 2 To be a church of encounter and witness, to grow in our ability to listen to people's lived experiences, to be more present to one another through our shared faith and more authentic in our witness to Christ in word and deed.

- 3 Finally, to strengthen the human family in our own homes, in our parishes, in our schools, and in places where the Lord sends us so that we learn to accompany people at all stages of life.

This pastoral renewal, through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, will enable us to respond better to the call for a deeper conversion and experience the renewal that is needed in our world today.

As we embark on this path of renewal in the Diocese may we share in the zeal and passion of St. Francis in following Christ, and may we imitate all the saints who accepted their call to renewal within the Church by choosing the path of courage, fidelity and humility in being one with the Lord.

# Pastoral Notes

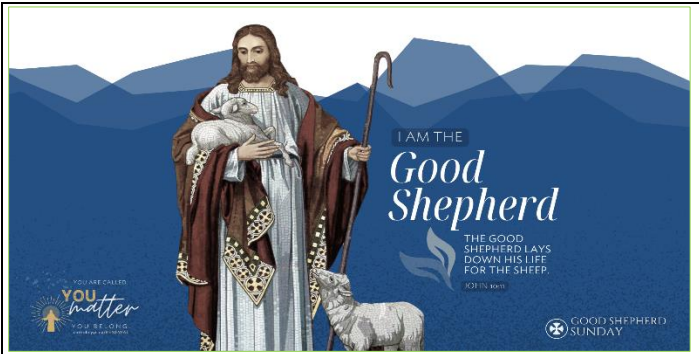
## The Chief Cornerstone

It is hopefully that throughout our Christian lives that we become more and more familiar with the Book of Psalms and count them among our favourite prayers. When I was about to be ordained a transitional deacon in 2010, I considered what scriptural verse I would put on my diaconal ordination card and eventually settled on a verse from Psalm 18:1 that proclaims " I love thee, O LORD, my strength. The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge."

Another beautiful image that emerges from the Psalms is in Psalm 118, which we will hear this Sunday, that speaks of the chief cornerstone. Every building in Ancient Israel had a cornerstone of which an edifice would be built, and it is the centuries' old custom for a cornerstone to be laid before the building of a new church. You can see the one here at St. Anthony's in the wall between the two separate pews nearby the statue of St. Anthony on the Gospel side of the sanctuary.

Though written centuries before the coming of Jesus into the world, the psalmist wrote in a prophetic manner to speak of the coming of the Christ, the one rejected by the religious leaders of his day but upon his Resurrection came to be known as the chief cornerstone upon which the new temple, the Body of Christ which is the Holy Catholic Church, would forever have foundation, strength and endurance.

May we continue to find strength and solace that Christ will forever be the chief cornerstone of the Church, helping her to endure all things, hope in all things, and be delivered from every evil.
