


## Pastoral Notes

### The Son of Encouragement

A priest's first Mass is a tremendous moment of grace. Mine took place on Saturday June 11th, 2011, the memorial of St. Barnabas. I am grateful that the Lord in His providence allowed me to offer the Holy Sacrifice on the feast of this saint of the Acts of the Apostles whose name means "son of encouragement". St. Barnabas was a man true to his name in the different ways he sought to encourage those who were struggling or looked on with suspicion in the early days of the Church. I prayed that day that St. Barnabas would accompany me as a priest to seek to encourage and support the People of God.

Many were rightly fearful of St. Paul for the ways he had previously persecuted the Church and may have questioned was he truly a disciple of Jesus and now wanting to proclaim the Good News in word and deed. St. Barnabas was willing to encourage and accompany St Paul to testify to the authenticity of his conversion and courage in which St Paul was proclaiming that Jesus is Lord.

There is a great need for all of us to seek to be sons and daughters of encouragement to our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ, especially if they have had the experience of being looked upon with suspicion or spoken poorly of for past transgressions but without appreciating the ways they are seeking to walk a path of conversion and renewal in Christ.






