Pastoral Notes

Divine Mercy in the Sacred Heart of Jesus

During my seminary studies, we were blessed to have in residence a retired Hungarian bishop named Attila Mikloszazy SJ. He was a formidable man, nearly 6.7 ft tall, and bore the name Attila well as he would pound his cane when a priest gave too long of a homily and whose booming voice would fill the seminary chapel whenever he preached (and had no concern if he preached too long...)

He was a fine theologian and had written extensively on devotion to the Sacred Heart. He noted that this devotion goes back to the time of the Apostles, who we read today were privileged to see the Lord's open side and know that the Sacred Heart was within, consoling them that they would never be alone since the Lord would welcome them into His heart whenever they were in need.

Bishop Mikloszazy also made a connection between devotion to the Sacred Heart and devotion to Divine Mercy, which we honour in a special way this Sunday. He suggested that devotion to Divine Mercy is a more contemporary way to honour the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He did not suggest we do away from traditional devotion to the Sacred Heart but that we see in the writings of St. Faustina and the more recent devotions like the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Novena and indulgences attached to the honouring the Lord's Divine Mercy on the Second Sunday of Easter, as another fitting way to pay homage to the heart of Jesus from which mercy continues to pour out into the world.

May we give praise and honour to the Heart that was pierced for our salvation by taking time this Sunday to pray before the image of Divine Mercy.

This Sunday I would also like to extend a word of welcome to Adele Gramlich who has begun her position as administrative assistant in our parish this week. Adele has been a parishioner of our parish for many years and comes to us with a wealth of experience. Please pray for her as she begins this new position in the life of our parish. I would also like to extend a word of thanks and gratitude to Dianne McKay who has departed from her role in the parish office. Dianne spent many years in our parish office and her ongoing dedication to our parish in assisting with funeral luncheons, Sunday socials and other areas of parish life is both inspiring and appreciated.


