As part of the diocesan wide parish renewal, a diocese wide survey has been created. The hope is for many in our parish to participate in completing this survey as a way for your voice to be heard.



Feed the Hungry has been providing a sit down meal at St. Mary's Hall since 1993. This full course meal includes salad, a hot entree, bread, dessert and an assortment of beverages.

Volunteers are an integral part of this ministry's success. The program equally becomes an opportunity for concerned and loving people to be part of the program to ensure our guests have a warm and welcoming experience each and every week. Sponsors typically commit to invite and bring some of these volunteers.



#### Sponsorship Details

**Time:** 11:00 am - 4:00 pm on Sunday

- Meal service starts at 1:30 pm.
- Volunteers arrive prior to the meal service and go on duty at different times throughout the day based on their assignment (see next page).

Talent: Each meal service requires some 72 volunteers. Usually, sponsors recruit and bring volunteers for their Sunday. Regular Feed the Hungry volunteers fill in whatever sponsors are unable to provide by way of volunteers. Volunteer opportunities include:

- Hall Set-up
- Main Door Hospitality
- Table Service
- Beverages, etc.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**



#### What is Feed The Hungry?

Feed The Hungry is a weekly Sunday lunch feeding program that serves a full course meal to homeless and underprivileged individuals and families within our community.

#### How many guests come each session?

Approximately 350 - 500 people enjoy the dine-in and take-out meals each week at Feed The Hungry.

#### How many volunteers usually serve every Sunday?

Usually, some 75 volunteers are needed to run a Sunday meal.

#### Where is the lunch served?

The feeding program is held at St. Mary's Hall (221-18th Ave., SW, Calgary) next to the Cathedral. It is one block west of St. Mary's High School or just east of St. Monica's Elementary School.

#### Who can volunteer?

Everyone can! It is recommended that those under age 12 work together with an adult during the shifts.

#### What time do volunteers need to be there?

Volunteers assisting in the morning shift (set-up) come at 11:00 am - 12:30 pm while those directly involved in the meal service come at 12:30 -4:00 pm.

#### Is there parking for volunteers?

There is parking behind the hall, in the church parking or in the St. Monica School parking lot right next to the hall. Volunteers are asked to leave valuables at home or to lock them in the trunk of their car.

#### How do volunteers access the Hall?

Volunteers are asked to enter the hall from the east side entrance through the small glass vestibule.

#### What do volunteers wear?

Out of respect for the guests, volunteers are asked to dress comfortably but conservatively. In order to comply with health & safety practices, **close toed shoes are required**. Aprons and serving gloves are provided. Coats can be hung on designated coat racks.

#### What should volunteers do upon arrival?

Once allowed to enter the hall, volunteers are asked to sign-in, make their name tags, and then report to the Assistant Coordinator. Area Leads will do the briefing of volunteers assigned in their areas.

#### Who do I call if I can't make my shift?

Please contact the coordinator or your sponsorship team prior to the event or call St. Mary's Hall on Sunday at (403) 228 5532.
