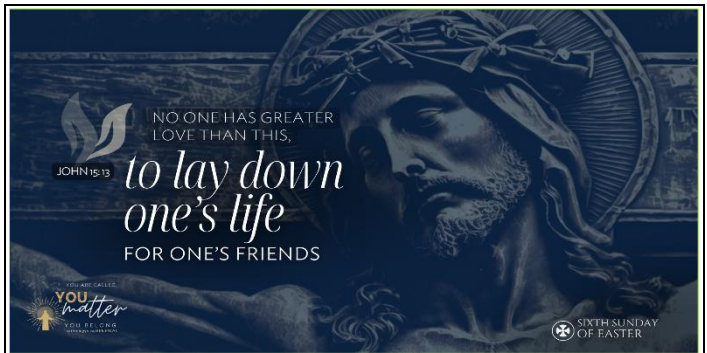
Pastoral Notes

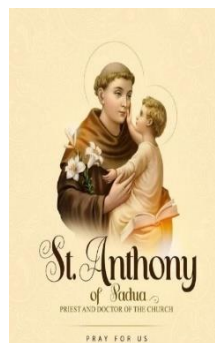
RACE NOTIFICATION

**PARTIAL ROAD CLOSURE
Macleod Trail (south bound lanes) AND
Elbow Drive (northbound lanes)**

- **7:15am Mass** - should not be impacted by road closures - there will be lanes closed on Macleod trail between 57 Ave SW and 61 Ave SW - expect slightly increased commute times
- **9:00am Mass** - all parishioners advised to be in parking lots (both Providence School and church) before 9:05 am or they won't be able to travel on 4 St SW - best approach from macleod trail & 57 st SW - approach up 4th street - no parking on the street.
- **10:30am Mass** - all parishioners advised to arrive early and potentially experience a wait if they want to park in parking lots (both Providence School and church) between 10:15 - 10:45am we will be able to move more cars across 4 ST SW - approach from elbow dr and either 52 or 53 Ave SW - no parking on 4 St SW
- **12:30pm Mass** - no impact to service - recommend approach from Elbow Dr if coming from South - Macleod Trail coming from the north
