FEED THE HUNGRY Sunday, June 9

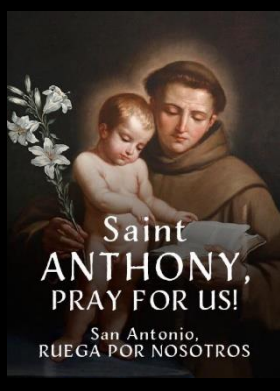

You can participate by serving and or by contributing to the \$6000 sponsorship towards which **\$1340 has been received**.

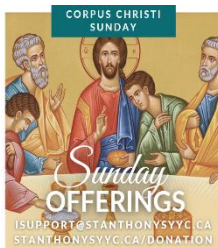

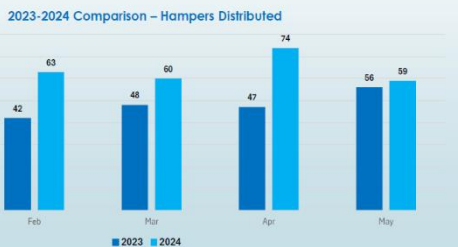
