It is great to be home!

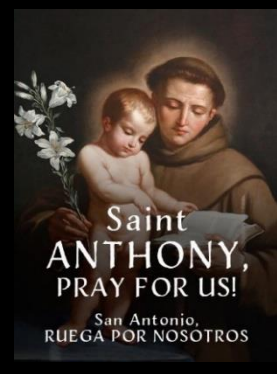
After a long and muggy summer in Washington DC, it is great to be home! This summer I faced 4 very different courses in the study of Canon Law. This included an overview of the penal section of the Code of Canon Law and seeing how the Church imposes censures and penalties as a means to draw people back to the Church who have gone astray but to also punish those who have inflicted grave harm on others as a means to protect the vulnerable and correct injustices that occur.

Courses in the Church's teaching office was a wonderful reminder of the ways Christ continues to teach the People of God through his bishops, catechists, religion teachers and publications, to name but a few, while my course in the Church's Temporal Goods was a way to understand how the Church operates under its law to manage properties and finances, discerns the opening and closure of parishes and seeks to protect its patrimony so future generations can appreciate its beauty and importance.

Finally, my course in Religious Liberty was an overview of how the Church seeks to uphold the right to religious liberty in the manifold ways it is both protected and undermined by governments, other religions and corporate powers around the world.

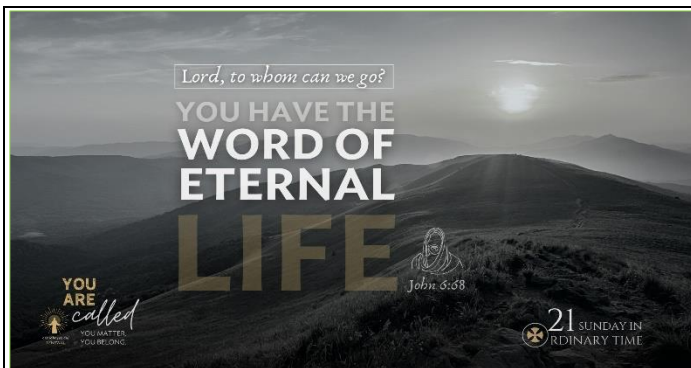
God willing, I will conclude my licentiate in Canon Law in summer 2025. 5 courses, a 50-60 page thesis and a looming comprehensive 1 hour final before a panel of 3 canon lawyers on the 1752 canons of the Code of Canon Law await! I am grateful for everyone's ongoing prayers, support and understanding as I enter this last stretch of studies and seek to balance my roles as your pastor and the chancellor of our Diocese.

I would like to take the opportunity this weekend to also welcome to our parish our new permanent deacon, Marc O'Loughlin and his wife Leonora. Deacon Marc was ordained this past June and in addition to being assigned to our parish will also be involved in the work of vocations in our diocese and is a member of the Diocesan renewal team. Please keep Deacon Mark, Leonora and their family in your prayers and please find a moment to welcome them both to our parish over the next few weekends.

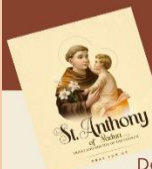

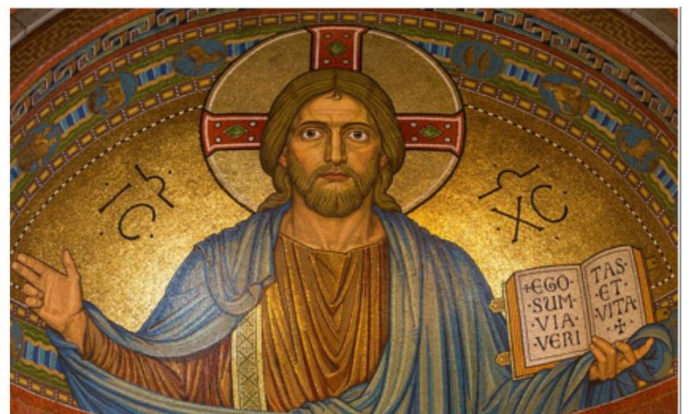
