
## Pastoral Notes

### The Value of Religion

The word religion is often looked upon with disdain in our present age. Many prefer to be known as "spiritual but not religious," in part because of negative connotations that get associated with the idea of religion as oppressive, intolerant and antiquated. It is noteworthy that the word religion, from the Latin *religio*, is often translated as "to bind or join together." Based on this definition, the purpose of religion is to unite people in a common purpose, which contradicts the modern dislike of the word for being the very opposite of what it is meant to be.

How then might we define the Catholic faith as a religion? It is a challenge to offer a neat and tidy definition but it is of note that St. James in our second reading this Sunday offers (what I believe) to be the only scriptural attempt at defining essential aspects of our religion: "religion that is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, is this: to care for orphans and widows in their distress, and to keep oneself unstained by the world." Now St. James was not attempting to define the entirety of the Catholic faith in this statement, but he was revealing to the people of his time and ours that the Christian religion will forever be defined by its care for the most needy among us and that daily struggle against sin and the ways that cause us to miss the mark in love of God and neighbour.

May we reflect on these words of St. James today to see how we are striving to make these aspects of our religion essential in our life of faith, and in doing so help to restore in our world a more positive and proper understanding of the enduring value of religion.


