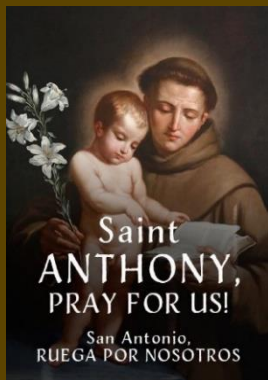
## Pastoral Notes

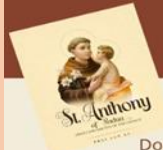
