

# Pastoral Notes

#### **But surely God is my Helper**

In this Sunday's Responsorial psalm, the psalmist exclaims with certainty that God is my Helper. We can all attest to the manifold ways God has offered us tremendous help and support and inspired others to imitate Him in being helpers to others. This past Saturday we witnessed many in our entire community come together to be of help and assistance to each other during our Fall Fair. Any chance we have to build up our entire faith community who come to St. Anthony's for the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is a powerful witness to the Lord's call for a unified Church, filled with disciples who have a mutual and genuine concern for the wellbeing of one another.

The Fall Fair was also a blessed opportunity for the entire parish community to continue our ongoing fundraising efforts for the new boiler. The project is nearing its completion. To date we have been invoiced and paid approximately \$250K for the project, leaving us with another approximately \$250k remaining to complete the project. The funds of our longstanding boiler fund that stand at approximately \$40k have not yet been used and will go towards paying our next invoice. We are getting closer and closer to having funded in full this project (which stands at approximately \$500k) and I express my gratitude once again to everyone who has made a monetary contribution to the new boiler. We face the prospect soon of needing to take out a loan with the Diocese of Calgary to complete this project. Those who able to contribute to the boiler project are encouraged to do so, if possible, soon, to reduce the debt amount we will likely incur.




