Pastoral Notes

Honouring the Holy Archangels

While not observed liturgically this year due to September 29th falling on a Sunday, this date is the current celebration of the feast of the Holy Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael. While in all likelihood there are numerous angels among the Heavenly Court that exist as members the angelic choir of archangels, the Holy Scriptures and Tradition of the Church have consistently attributed names to three of the archangels of God. The names of angels are mysterious and on numerous occasions in the Old Testament humanity is warned against asking angels to reveal their names, but in the case of these three archangels, each of them announced their names for us to know and honour, since their names tell us something of the mission that they were given by God.

Michael means he who is like God. The likeness of this holy archangel to God is seen in the never-failing protection he has given to the People of God from the very dawn of creation until the end of days when he will do battle with Satan and be victorious. Gabriel means God is my strength. This holy archangel provided strength to both the prophet Daniel when he experienced many of his apocalyptic visions about future events and to Holy Mary when he assured her to not be afraid but to rejoice that she was to become the Mother of God and that the Lord would strengthen her at every moment of her pilgrimage of faith upon earth until her Assumption in Heaven. Raphael means The Medicine of God. This archangel provided both physical healing when he cured Tobit of his blindness and spiritual healing when exorcised the demon that had prevented Sarah from being married in the past and assured that her marriage to Tobias would be holy and righteous in God's sight.

Might we become accustomed to calling on the Holy Archangels in times when we need protection from any powers that might oppress us, strength in times of fear or difficulty, and healing in the manifold ways we require the healing power of God in our lives.



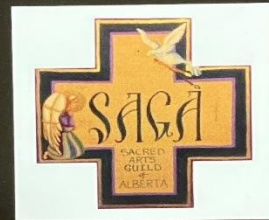

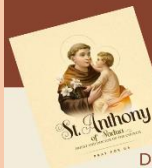

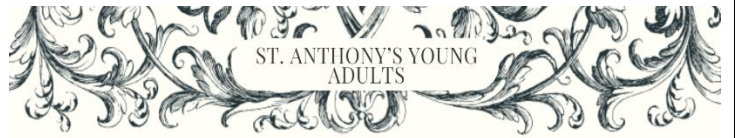
