# Pastoral Notes

## Praise the Lord

Psalms 146-150 are the final four psalms that conclude the Book of Psalms. Fittingly, these 4 psalms are all psalms of praise. Praise and exaltation of God are the constant theme that runs through the words, images and sentiments expressed in these ancient and sacred hymns. While so much of the Book of Psalms will focus on expressing other human emotions and experiences rooted in loss, suffering, fear, anger, joy, celebration, etc., it is beautiful that the final words to end the Psalms are to praise God; for in the end, after we go through so many trials in life, it is hopeful that our final words to God can be those of praise and prepare us for the unending experience of praising God forever in Heaven.

The responsorial refrain from Psalm 146 this Sunday, "Praise the Lord, O my soul" is one that we can all hopefully make our own. God made us to praise Him, not because He needs our praise because He does not, but because He knows how much more joyful we will be in this life if we can express our praise for Him, especially in those moments when we do not want to or question why we should praise Him when things do not go as we hope in life.

Please take time this weekend to reread the words of Psalm 146 and to consider the areas of my life where I know I can praise God and those areas where I do not praise Him but know deep within that I should.

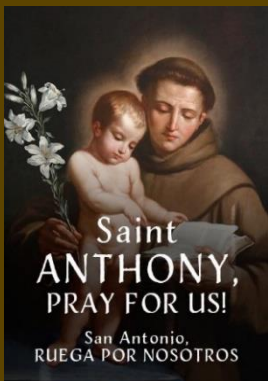

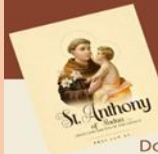
