
Pastoral Notes

In all things give thanks

As we gather this weekend to celebrate Thanksgiving in Canada, (of which my American canon law classmates remind me that it is a strange holiday since they cannot understand why we do not celebrate it on the 4th Thursday of November, but I digress), it is important that we consider to what extent we also give thanks to God. The scriptures are filled with psalms, prayers, exaltations, and teachings that speak of the need to thank God and among these verses the one that resonates greatly with me is 1 Thessalonians 5: 16-18, where St Paul exclaims: "Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all things give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you all."

It is significant that St. Paul exclaimed that we are to give thanks in all things, not just when times are good but also when times are tough, and when it is difficult to see why in His permissive will God allows for many things to occur that seem to be the very opposite of occasions for thanksgiving. But if we can ask for the grace and ability to thank God in all things, we can be affirmed that we are seeking more and more to unite our wills to that of Jesus Christ, who also gave us the example of thanking His Father in all things.

May the Lord grant each of us a blessed Thanksgiving and keep us ever mindful of those who are suffering greatly in our world, that they will be given respite from their sufferings and have the ability to still give thanks to God in the challenges they face.




