


# Pastoral Notes

#### Grateful for my Catholic Education

As we celebrate Catholic Education Sunday in our diocese this weekend. I spent some time this week thinking about my own experience of going to a Catholic school. I attended kindergarten through grade 6 in the public system at Millarville Community School. I enjoyed my elementary years there, in part because I could walk through the forest to school from my home and then ascend the large hill my family home resided upon after school was done, and for the fact that even though it was a public school, the Christian faith was present, be it in the yearly Nativity play we had for the annual Christmas concert or the kindness my grade 2 teacher showed me in allowing me to do a presentation to my classmates about my First Holy Communion, of which I think few understood but were intrigued that I had eaten the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

However, there was something notable in moving from Millarville Community School to Holy Trinity Academy in Okotoks for grades 7-12 in the comfort that came from being in a school where there was daily prayer, visible signs of faith like crucifixes in classrooms and classes dedicated to teaching religion. Like ever Catholic school, HTA had its own challenges in teaching and living the fullness of the Catholic faith, but the overall spirit of the school was that Catholicism was at it's heart and was evident in the witness of many of its teachers, two of whom made a huge impact on me in wanting to learn more about our faith and would eventually be two of the people who wrote me letters of recommendation to enter the seminary, even if I had not thought much about a vocation in high school, these two teachers saw something in me that I was not yet ready to perceive as a teenager.

I share these memories with you this weekend as a sign of my gratitude for the Catholic education I received and pray that many can testify to the same. Please continue to pray for our Catholic schools in Alberta and for the ongoing freedom for parents to choose the best manner of schooling for their children in our province. 


