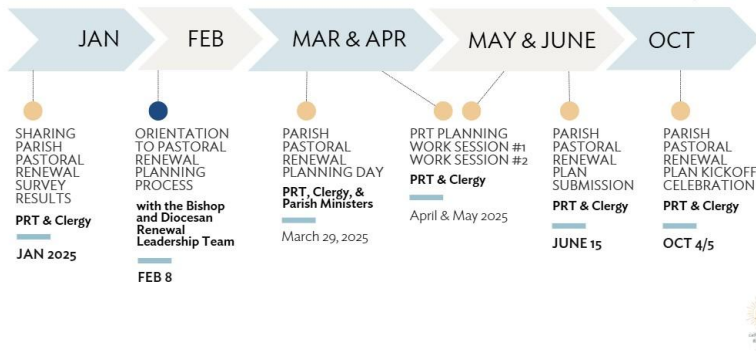

Pastoral Notes

Trust in the Lord

The refrain from this Sunday's responsorial psalm is very consoling: Blessed the one who trusts in the Lord. This refrain can be applied to each of the 150 psalms. Even though the psalms speak of nearly every experience under the sun, from joy to sorrow, from rejoicing in new life to mourning those who die a violent death, to thanking God for His blessings to begging His mercy and asking to be delivered from destruction, each and every psalm implores its listener to trust in the Lord in every situation.

The result of trusting God in all that unfolds in our lives is the promise of being blessed or happy in return. While much of what is recorded in the psalms seems to be the very opposite of happiness, there remains the choice of either striving to trust God when things go badly or to abandon Him and find ourselves plunged into even greater doubt and misery.

Certainly we will know happiness when we trust in God and things go according to our hopes and dreams, but do we also believe that we will be happy when they do not and when we fail to understand why God allowed such things to happen?

May we all take to heart this challenge of trusting God in everything and ask for Him to show us where happiness is found in doing so.

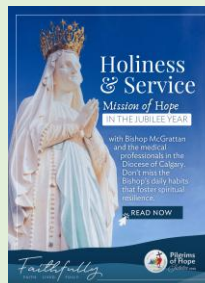
