Pastoral Notes

The First Profession of Faith

Every Sunday, we recite together the Nicene Creed (or during the Lenten and Easter Seasons, The Apostles Creed). Composed after the Council of Nicaea in the 3rd Century AD, the recitation of the creed has been an integral part of Sunday Mass and other notable liturgical celebrations, such as during the baptism of an infant when the parents and godparents profess their belief in the tenants of the Creed on behalf of the infant who is unable to do so.

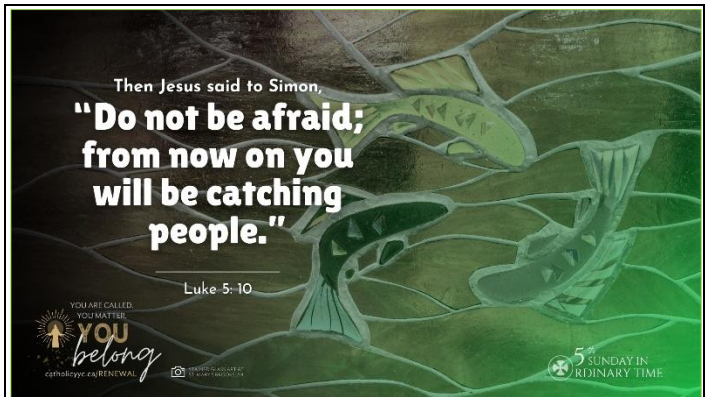
But there has existed in our Church similar creeds that profess the essential elements of the Paschal Mystery which predate the Creeds we profess at Mass. The most ancient of them all is found in our second reading this Sunday from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians. In a brief but profound statement, St Paul proclaims to the church in Corinth the saving message that was given to him: That Jesus died in accord with the scriptures, was buried, rose on the third day, then appeared to Cephas (St Peter), the twelve apostles and more than five hundred eyewitnesses before he also appeared to St Paul on the road to Damascus.

St Paul shared with the Corinthians what is the central mystery of the Christian faith: that Christ died for us, rose again in glory, and then appeared to hundreds of people so that there would be many credible eyewitnesses who could in turn go out into all the world to proclaim that Jesus is the Lord and salvation comes through him and His Church.

There are so many aspects of our Catholic Faith that we have a lifetime to learn more about. But it is important that from time to time we remind ourselves of what are the most important teachings that we have been given. May this short passage from St Paul serve as a meaningful source of meditation for us all as we ponder this great mystery of his dying and rising to eternal life.

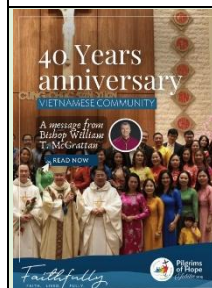
