Pastoral Notes

Full of the Holy Spirit

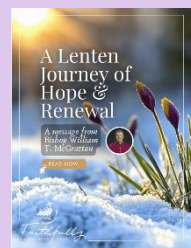
The story of Jesus' 40 day sojourn in the desert is well known to Catholic Christians. For centuries, the Gospel reading for the 1st Sunday of Lent places us in the harshness of the Judean desert to witness the 3 temptations that Satan puts before the Son of God.

A detail from St. Luke's account of this scene is one that often gets overlooked. It says that Jesus, "full of the Holy Spirit," was led by that same Creator Spirit into the wilderness to undergo his fast and time of temptation. The Lord did not go into this time of prayer, fasting and temptation unprepared. Rather, He was fortified by the same Spirit that accompanied Him throughout His ministry.

Likewise, as we enter the opening days of our Lenten fast, we too should ask the Holy Spirit to fill us with His grace. Let us ask the Holy Spirit to enkindle in our hearts a deeper urgency to pray, a greater resolve to hold fast to those resolutions to fast and a cheerful charity to be placed deep within our souls to joyfully give alms.

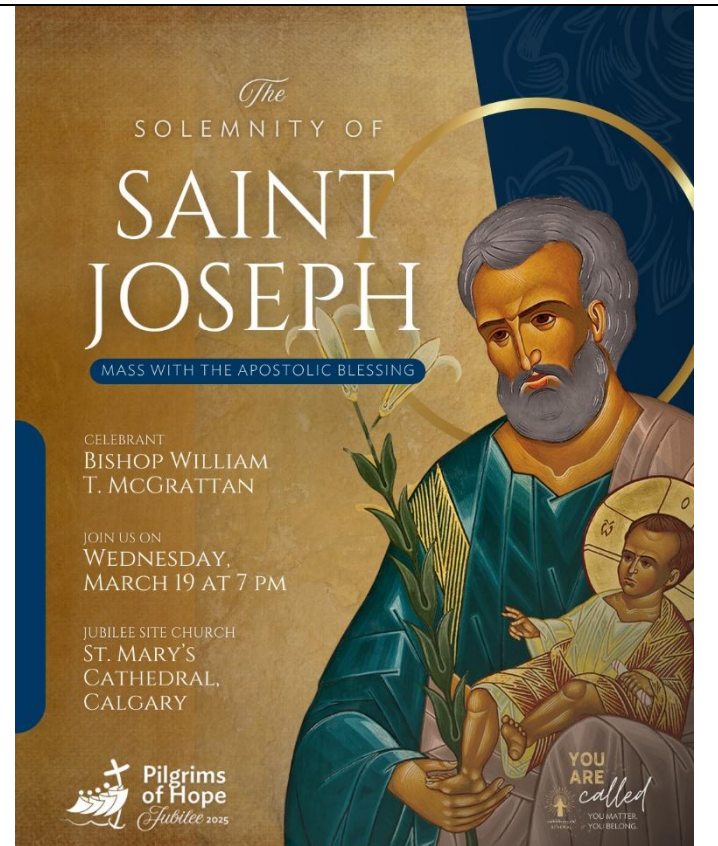
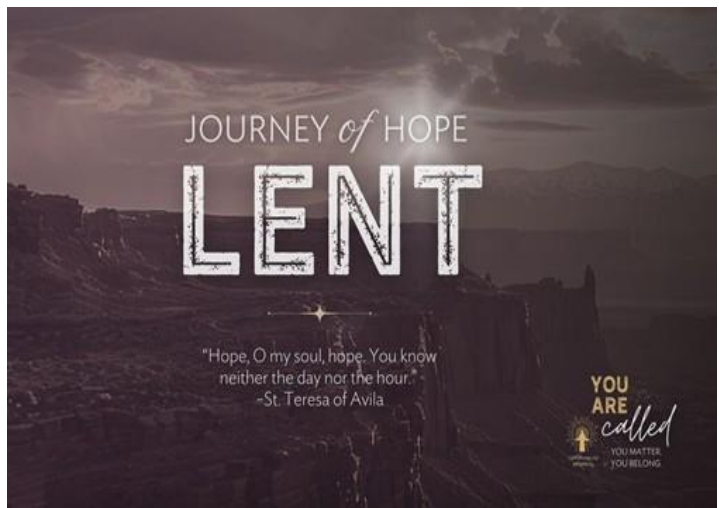
