Pastoral Notes

Whom shall I fear?

Psalm 27 poses an important question to each of us to consider: "whom shall I fear?" The psalmist is confident that because God is our light and our salvation, then we should fear nothing. This is objectively true, but elsewhere in the psalms the same poet often speaks of the terrible fear and dread that fills his soul, so much so that in Psalm 88 he laments that "my one companion is darkness."

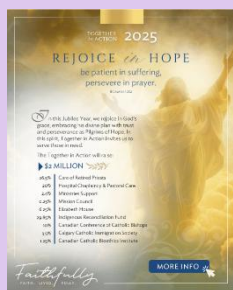
As Christians, we live with a certain tension of knowing and believing that we should fear nothing because God is on our side, but also experiencing moments and situations filled with genuine fear and dread, making it difficult to see how God is present when it seems like the darkness of fear is prevailing over the light of trust.

Lent is an opportune time for us to confront this tension if we know it is present in our lives. Our time of lenten prayer could focus on the fears we are currently experiencing by asking God to give us a greater trust in Him and awareness of how we can, with the help of His grace, be set free from the fears that abide in our hearts.

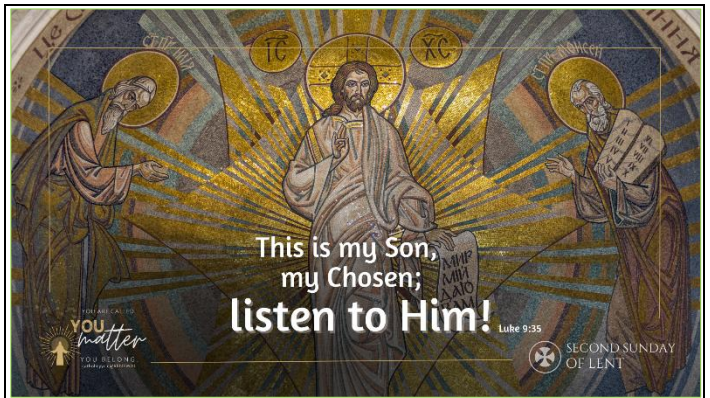

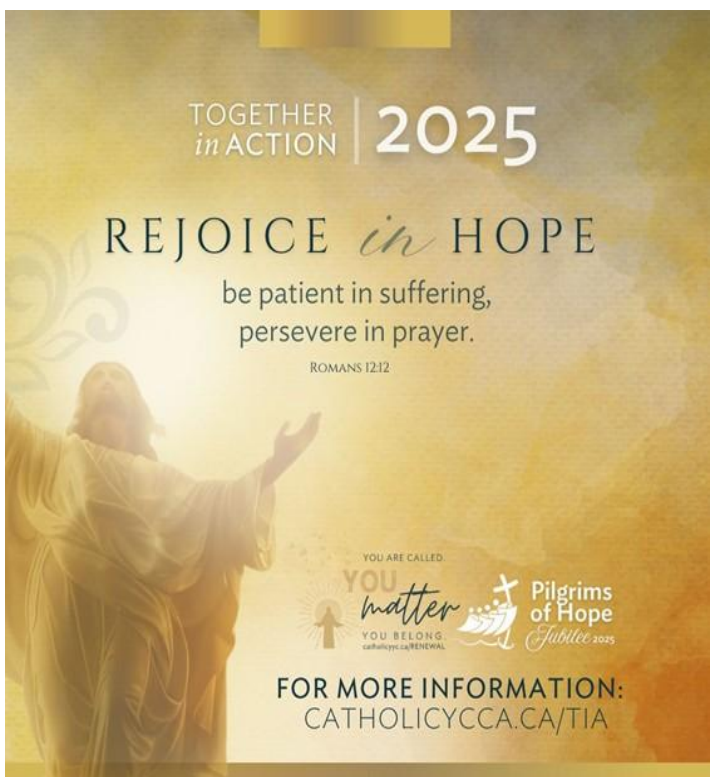

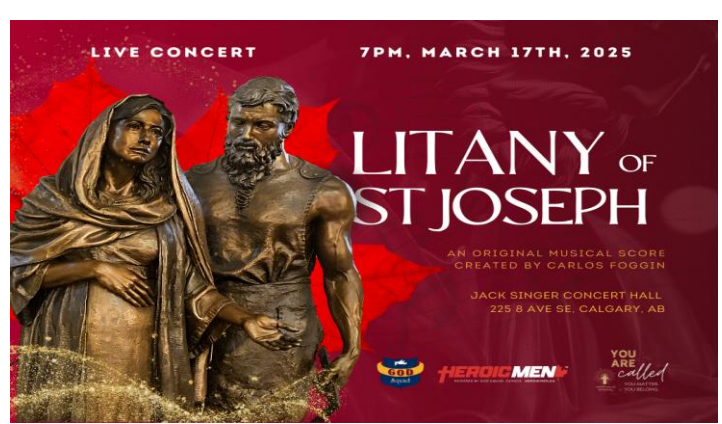
