It is often said that Christmas is the most wonderful time of the year. It is certainly among the most joyful and wonderful seasons for Christians as we celebrate the birth of Christ, but could we not say that Lent is also among the most wonderful times of the year?

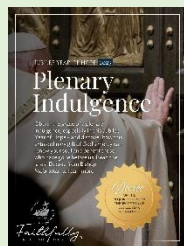
It is truly a wondrous season when we consider that year after year, God, in His infinite love, mercy and care for each of us, invites us to go into the desert with his Son and engage in those essential spiritual practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. He invites us on this yearly pilgrimage to help us look deep within our hearts to see if a treasury of good or evil resides within. It is so easy for us to misplace our priorities, placing God far from our minds and having our thoughts and intentions fixated on ourselves and worldly things, to the detriment of our souls in seeing them drift further away from what is really important.

Lent is a time to reorientate the heart back to God and begin to replenish that treasury of the heart that is meant to overflow with times of daily prayer, acts of fasting and self-denial to make more space for God to speak, and alms given sacrificially, least we fall into that tendency of giving God our spare change but keeping our treasury primarily to ourselves.

The opportunity during Lent to yearly bring our hearts back to God is what makes it truly a wondrous time, and one that is so very necessary as we walk the narrow path of salvation with Him.



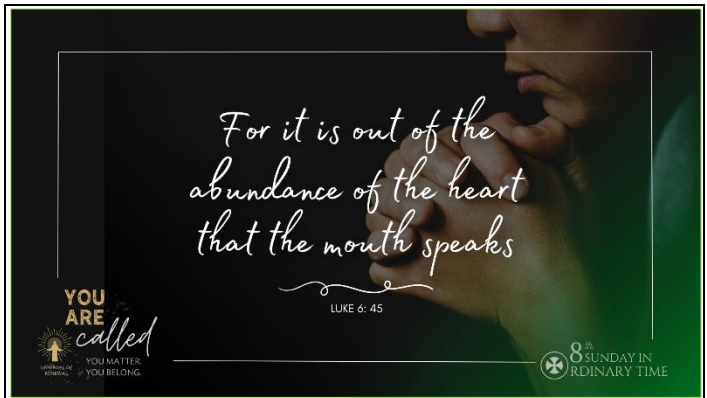

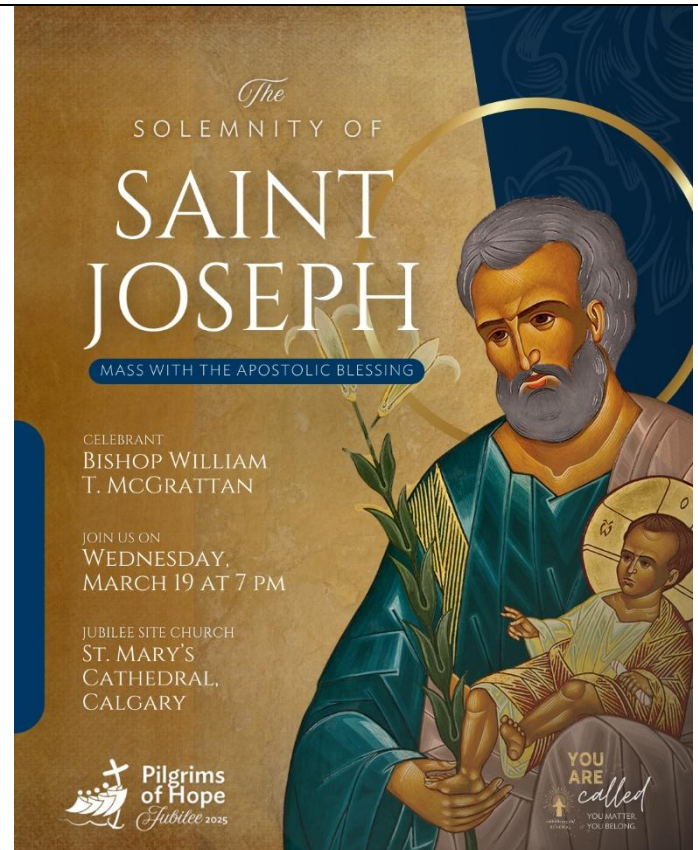

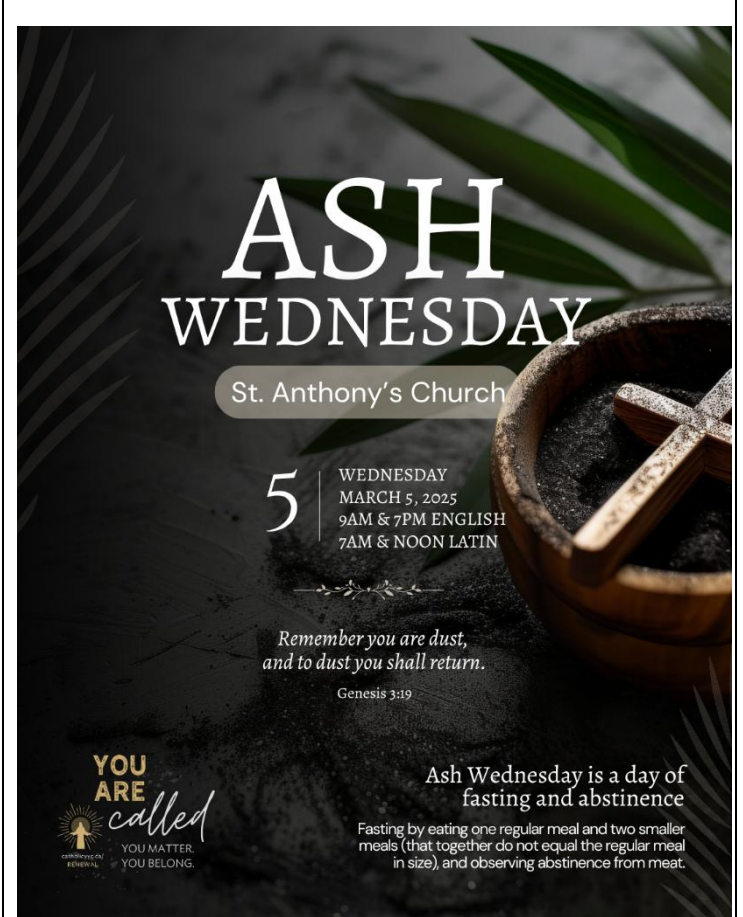
