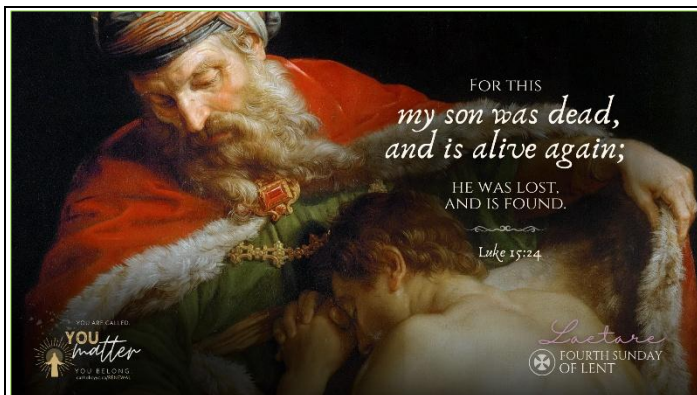
# Pastoral Notes

## Lenten Perseverance

As the Christian faithful approach the halfway point of Lent this Sunday, the temptation to lessen our time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving may be heightened. For some, Lent up to this point may have seen us do well in keeping the resolutions we began on Ash Wednesday, and so the temptation to ease up on them may start to emerge. For others, Lent up to this point has been fraught with failing to keep our resolutions that we made on Ash Wednesday, and so the temptation to despair and give up entirely may be present. And for many, Lent up to this point has probably been a mix of success and failure to keep our resolutions, and so the temptation towards a certain mediocrity to try and finish Lent well may be stirring in many souls.

This 4th Sunday of Lent, traditionally known as Laetare Sunday, serves as a good opportunity to consider how we will persevere in our Lenten resolutions as a means to help us pray well during Holy Week and rejoice on Easter Sunday. We can imagine that it was around this time that Christ began to turn his gaze to Jerusalem and the sacred drama that was to unfold there from his triumphant entrance on Palm Sunday, to the mysteries that would unfold on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, and the start of new life on Easter Sunday.

Let us then pray for each other to persevere in what remains of Lent and imagine ourselves walking beside Jesus with our eyes also fixed towards Jerusalem and those mysteries of salvation that we are soon to relive.
