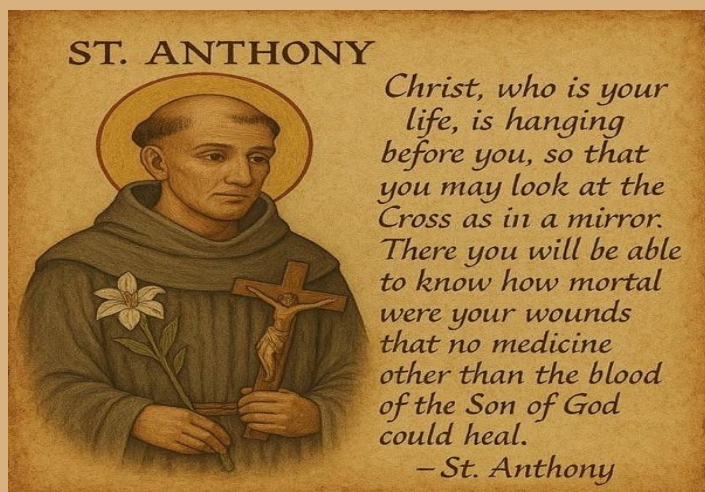
Entering Holy Week and Beyond

As Catholics, there is no greater time in the liturgical year than the sacred drama that unfolds in Holy Week and the Easter Season. Starting on Palm Sunday, we accompany our Lord to the Holy City of Jerusalem and relive those key moments of our salvation: The Last Supper, the Passion and Death of Christ, the Descent of Jesus into the underworld and His Glorious Resurrection.

Starting with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, it is significant that this celebration does not conclude with the usual final blessing. This is to indicate that the celebration that began that evening does not end, but extends into the following days and only concludes with the final blessing at the Easter Vigil. The liturgies of those three days form into a single, continuous celebration!

After the Masses of Easter Sunday, it is important for us to realize Easter does not end that Sunday, but will continue for the next 50 days. One day would not suffice to celebrate the day Jesus rose from the dead! Instead, we are to rejoice and contemplate the mystery of His rising to new life and the invitation to believe in His resurrection, so that we might one day share in its glory in heaven and at the resurrection of the righteous.

Let us pray for each other during Holy Week and throughout the Easter Season, that it be a time of renewal in Christ and an opportunity for our parish to grow as an even greater witness to His Death and Resurrection.

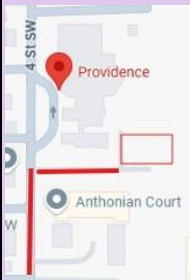
