

Pastoral Notes

Good Evening and Thank You

The first and last words that Pope Francis uttered during his 12 year pontificate were "Good evening" and "Thank you." The Pope from Argentina was announced to the Eternal City and the World with a simple greeting. The Vicar of Christ departed this world with an equally simple greeting. Yet both of them are marked with a sense of gratitude.

Too often we overlook the importance of gratitude in our life of faith. It was evident in the life and ministry of Pope Francis that he was grateful to God for the life he lived, the vocation he was given and the ways God sustained him as he journeyed through his own vale of tears with the hope of one day resting in the Eternal Garden.

During these 9 days of mourning for the Holy Father, which is an ancient roman tradition of that pre-dates the coming of St. Peter and the Catholic Church to Rome, may we be generous in offering prayers for the repose of his soul, and also offer a prayer of gratitude to God for the ways in which the Holy Father made an impact in our lives. Whether we deeply loved and supported the Pope or struggled to accept the ways in which he served as Vicar of Christ, each of us have been marked by his papacy and it is hopeful that some sense of gratitude can be found in the ways he both strengthened and challenged each of us.

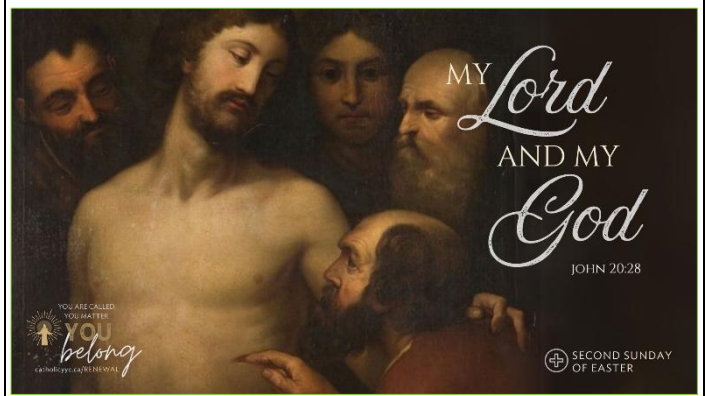
Let us also pray for the cardinals of the Church as they prepare to enter the Conclave and elect a new Vicar of Christ. May each member of the College of Cardinals be profoundly filled with the Holy Spirit to discern wisely who will be the next Pope whom St. Catherine of Siena once called the "Sweet Christ on Earth."

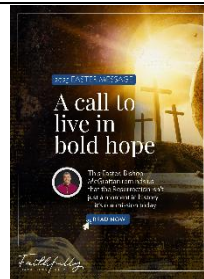
